MENTOR Independence Region (MIR) is seeking young people to participate in focus groups to share their opinions and experiences about how adults show up for young people.

The purpose of this focus group is to hear what young people think about mentoring. MIR sees mentoring as adult-youth relationships grounded in love and caring with a common purpose and eye to the future. MIR wants to know what youth have, want, and need from their relationships with adults in order to thrive. MIR sees young people as experts who know best about their lives and what they want from mentoring relationships. MIR wants to work with young people to understand the impact of positive mentoring relationships on young people's lives.
